


SISTERS OF ST. MARTHA INSTALL NEW LEADERSHIP TEAM

Antigonish – Monday, July 29th was the Feast Day of St. Martha, Mary, and Lazarus. The Sisters of St. Martha celebrated this day by renewing their vows. Every five years the celebration includes the Rite of Installation of the new Leadership Team. This year marked the double celebration.

"Yes, we are willing to accept this role." With Martha simplicity, the newly elected Leadership Team accepted their willingness to carry the responsibility of stewarding the life and mission of the Congregation and to assist in the unfolding and the implementation of the Sacred Word of our Direction Statement of General Chapter 2024.

The Ritual of Transition for the new Leadership Team of the Congregation marked the passing on of the "KEY" from the former Team to the incoming one.
